CODE EXERCISE

JAVASCRIPT CONDITIONALS

Welcome to the tennis club!

We're writing some code to calculate the club members' monthly fee bill. Create a new .html file with script tags as demonstrated in the video. Inside your script tags insert the following line:

let amount = prompt("How much did the member spend this month in additional charges?");

This will prompt the user for an amount spent and assign the amount entered to the variable amount. In this organization, we must charge a tax of 6.25% on all memberships and additional charges. The basic membership fee is \$500 a month. However, most members spend additional money on gear, at the club café or on tennis lessons. Discounts are applied based on the amount spent above the \$500 fee according to the following schedule, however the entire monthly bill is discounted:

\$250 - \$500	10%
\$501 - \$1,000	12.5
\$1,001 - \$2,000	15%
\$2,001 or more	20%

Based on the user input, output their bill, discount, tax and total.

For example for a member who spend \$820 in additional feed their bill should look like this:

Membership Fee	\$500
Additional Fees	\$820

Subtotal Discount 12 5%

Final Fee Bill Tax

Grand Total \$1227.19
